

Driver's Education

You may obtain your entry level learner permit to drive if you are at least **15 years of age:**

- Wait.
Your permit may expire before you are ready to get a license. It is recommended to start Driver's Ed 3 or 4 months before turning 16, or you may need to renew the permit.
- Go to Utah Driver's License Division office at the county courthouse.
If you plan to walk-in for your visit you can complete the application in the office, or ahead of time [online](#). (click link or scan QR code to the right)
- Plan on having your photo taken.
- Provide proof of identity, full social security number and two (2) documents of Utah residence.
If under age 18, proof of residence can be mail sent to your legal guardian.
- Pass the 50-question written knowledge test, study this [driver hand-book](#).
(click link or scan QR code to the right)
- Pass the eye test.
- Parent/legal guardian must sign for financial responsibility (17 and under only.)
- Submit a nonrefundable fee of \$19.00

Driver's Handbook

A permit is required before you can start any Driver's Ed class, and ...

You must have a permit for at least 6 months before you can get your license.

To begin Driver's Education:

- Go to Uintah High School finance office.
- Pay the appropriate fee to be placed in a course.
The online class is \$260. The class is open enrollment and it runs all year including the summer.
The class at the high school is \$200. The class is during the school day.
Students must have a permit and pay the fee before the class starts.
The fees include the driving and the driving test.
