Mrs. Shipton shared information on two different Conferences. The first-year and second-year teachers attended a PLC conference in October. Those teachers then trained the staff on what they learned including Feedback, Engagement Doing Whatever it Takes, and Responding to Student Needs (interventions). Mrs. Shipton plans to take 5 teachers to a Workshop on Leading Standards-Based Learning. This will be in March. Those teachers will also come back and train the staff on what they have learned.
